SECTION 2: Supply Chain Program to Receive data from Growers

To participate in the Supply Chain Program, a representative of the handling facility needs to read and agree with the following terms and conditions. Handlers can opt-out at any time by contacting CASP@sureharvest.com. Successfully maintaining data in a secure and confidential manner is a hallmark of CASP since 2009.

Terms and Conditions

Once 10 orchards have agreed to share data with a handler, the CASP platform will combine results and provide access to an anonymized, aggregated report that includes the orchard count and acreage for overall sharing, CASP assessment status, Irrigation Improvement Continuum, SAI Platform Farm Sustainability Assessment performance and Bee Friendly Farming Certification Eligibility status. If the number of shared orchards drops below 10, the aggregate reporting will no longer be available. Growers can stop sharing with their handler on the CASP software platform at any time. Growers that have agreed to share data with their handler may voluntarily choose to share their name and contact details through the CASP platform, but assessment data will never be linked to individual growers.
